

DESCRIPTION:

Metz Cleaner is a specially formulated blend of solvents which is designed to clean uncured Metz compounds from tile or brick surfaces, tools, mixing equipment, etc.

RECOMMENDED:

Used for cleaning the following Metz products:

- i) METZ Epoxies - 4HB-EN, 5EN, 5NF, 5NFA, 6B, 6M, 10, 10EN, 20E, 33 products, 33EN products and 44-SL.
- ii) METZ Vinyl Ester - 10VE, 14VE
- iii) METZ Polyurethanes - 20B, 20P, 92, 93PU, 94
- iv) METZ Furanes - 12P, 12PHF, 12P/2

Note: Special cleaners can be supplied for other compounds on request. Consult Metz for advice regarding removal of cured Metz cements and compounds.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

- a) The cleaner is only effective on uncured cements. Clean up must take place before the Metz cements begin to set (refer to individual Metz Data Sheets).
- b) Use only minimum amount of cleaner to clean tile/brick surfaces. Avoid excessive use of cleaner on tile/brick joints as this will adversely affect jointing cement. Wipe surfaces with clean, absorbent cloth, dampened with appropriate Metz Cleaner.
- c) Metz cleaner is flammable. No smoking. Do not allow welding, grinding or other spark producing activities in the vicinity of cleaners.
- d) Provide adequate ventilation (exhaust ventilation necessary when cleaners used in confined spaces).
- e) Do not use Metz cleaners for cleaning hands etc. Use soap and water only or special cleaning compounds.
