- b) Use only minimum amount of cleaner to clean tile/brick surfaces. Avoid excessive use of cleaner on tile/brick joints as this will adversely affect jointing cement. Wipe surfaces with clean, absorbent cloth, dampened with appropriate Metz Cleaner.
- c) Remove any excess cleaner. Do not allow to pool on surfaces.
- d) Provide adequate ventilation.
- e) Do not use Metz cleaners for cleaning hands etc. Use soap and water only or special cleaning compounds.
